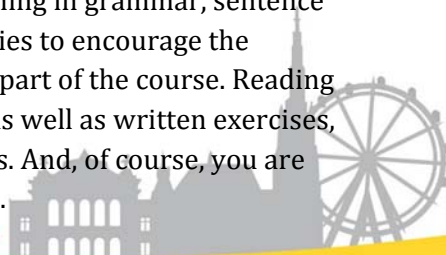
Course Objectives

The intention of this course is to improve general German language skills and communication both as a speaker and instructor, to be used in educational, social and vocational contexts and learn more about Austrian history and culture.

The Standard Course classes teach general German, and the teacher training provides insight into up-to-date teaching methods and materials.

Course Contents

This German and Teacher Training course aims to develop all four language skills of German: listening, speaking, reading and writing. The programme provides intensive coaching in grammar, sentence structure and vocabulary. Various activities to encourage the acquisition of vocabulary are an integral part of the course. Reading and listening comprehension exercises, as well as written exercises, are important components of our courses. And, of course, you are encouraged to speak as much as possible.

Speaking Skills

Speaking will be an integral part of lessons. Students can express their ideas in small groups in a relaxed classroom atmosphere. By use of a range of activities communication is encouraged and students become more confident in this skill.

Reading Skills

A variety of reading activities is used to encourage students to develop effective reading skills.

Listening Skills

Listening skills will be practised, using a variety of activities and tasks to enable students to process information effectively.

Writing Skills

Writing will be practised in different genres. Writing may also be set for homework.

Grammar Awareness

Grammar for effective communication will be practised at all levels.

Vocabulary

The acquisition of vocabulary is an integral part of the course, as it is a key element in learning a foreign language.
