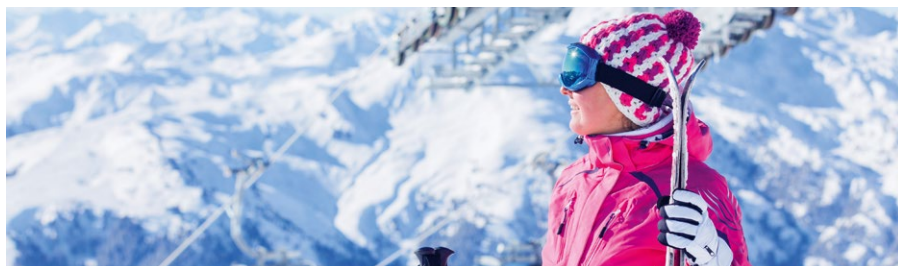


## December-March

## Ski resorts



### Stuhleck, Styria

At an elevation of 770 - 1770 m, the World Cup resort Stuhleck offers over 20 km of ski slopes for all levels of difficulty, 10 skiing lifts - among them Austria's longest chair lift - and a snowboarding fun park are just 1 ½ hours train journey from Vienna.

Price: approx. EUR 60-70.- (full-day excursion)

### Zauberberg/Semmering, Lower Austria

Zauberberg, next to the FIS World Cup slope and just 2 hours journey from Vienna offers, at an altitude of 1000-1360 m, over 10 km of slopes where beginners as well as professionals can enjoy their day. In the Split-Park, freeskiers and boarders can show their skills.

Price: approx. EUR 60-70.- (full-day excursion)

- ▶ Hire of skiing equipment: approx. EUR 25-50.-/day.
